# ON STREET LITTER ENFORCEMENT CONTRACT

# **Reference Report:**

On-Street Litter Enforcement Contract

# **Decision:**

- (1) That the extension of the existing concessionary contract arrangement to 31<sup>st</sup> May 2014 with an appropriate provider through a negotiated arrangement be approved.
- (2) Officers be authorised to review the existing service model and enter into negotiations, through a concessionary pricing contract, with service providers to establish an appropriate service model from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2014.

#### Reasons:

The trial arrangement with Kingdom Security Ltd, who acquired XFOR in February 2013, expired on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2013. It is intended to regularise and extend the current arrangements with an appropriate provider through a negotiated arrangement until May 2014. This will allow time for a detailed review of the provision of this service and consideration of future options.

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Environment PDS Committee on 19th November 2013 and the Committee supported the proposal.
