SEVENOAKS WAY (A224) PROPOSED UTC SCOOT SYSTEM

Reference Report:

Sevenoaks Way (A224) Proposed, UTC Scoot System Enc. 1 for Sevenoaks Way (A224) Proposed, UTC Scoot System

Decision:

(1) That the proposal to introduce a UTC Scoot system to this section of the A224 Cray Avenue/Sevenoaks Way from Poverest Road to Main Road be approved.

(2) That authority be delegated to the Executive Director of Environment and Community Services, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder and Ward Members, to approve the scheme's detailed design.

Reasons:

This section of the A224 along Cray Avenue and Sevenoaks Way is one of the most congested roads in the borough. Various proposals have been made to aid traffic movements and reduce congestion, some of which are currently being installed. In order to maximise the benefits of these improvements it is proposed to install a system that will link the traffic lights along the route and improve traffic flow.

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Environment PDS Committee on 19th November 2013 and the Committee supported the proposal.
