Reasons:

Concerning public conveniences closed in the first phase of implementation of the Community Toilet Scheme, offers have been accepted for the three sites marketed, and two of the sites have now been sold.

In December 2012, the sale or demolition of a second tranche of sites was agreed, and the sites at Coney Hall, Elmers End and Green Street Green were subsequently marketed for sale.
