## STATEMENT OF EXECUTIVE DECISION

The Portfolio Holder for Public Protection and Safety, Councillor Kate Lymer has made the following executive decision:

### **DOGS AND PEST CONTROL**

#### **Reference Report:**

*Dogs and Pest Control, 28/09/2016 Public Protection and Safety Policy Development and Scrutiny Committee*

#### **Decision:**

The Portfolio Holder agreed to re-tender the Stray and Abandoned Dogs and Pest Control services for a period of three years, with the potential to extend for two further years, at an estimated total contract value of £620k.

The Portfolio Holder also agreed to delegate authority to the Executive Director of Environment and Community Services (in consultation with herself) to extend the contract if required.

#### **Reasons:**

The final extension on Bromley's contracts for the Stray and Abandoned Dogs and Pest Control Services expires on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017. The report submitted for pre decision scrutiny to the PPS/PDS Committee on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2016 outlined the service requirements and the recommended commissioning strategy to ensure service continuity from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017.

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Public Protection and Safety PDS Committee on 28th September 2016 and the Committee supported the proposal.
