Reasons:

The Food Safety Service Plan outlines a range of objectives for 2017/18 which have been developed to address a number of issues identified by the Food Standards Agency following its audit of the Food Safety Service in April 2017, including the delivery of a comprehensive programme of inspections. The delivery of the Food Safety Service Plan will be supported by additional resources agreed by the Council's Executive at its meeting on 9th August 2017, including funding to appoint two full-time permanent and three full-time temporary food safety officers for a period of up to 18 months.

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Public Protection and Safety PDS Committee on 27th September 2017 and the Committee supported the proposal.
