**Decision:**

**The scheme to be recommended in the August 2018 consultation exercise for the Authority's 2019/20 Council Tax Support/Reduction scheme is to be the same as currently in place i.e. the minimum contribution of working aged claimants remaining at 25% of a household's Council Tax liability.**

**Reasons:**

The Local Authority is required to undertake an annual public consultation exercise to seek resident's views of the Council Tax Support/Reduction scheme to be operated in the following financial year. The consultation exercise commencing in August 2018 will be based on the minimum contribution of working aged claimants to a household's Council Tax liability remaining at 25%.

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Executive, Resources and Contracts PDS Committee on 5th July 2018 and the Committee supported the proposal.
