2019/20 DEDICATED SCHOOLS GRANT

Reference Report:

2019/20 DEDICATED SCHOOLS GRANT, 23/01/2019 Education, Children and Families Budget and Performance Monitoring Sub-Committee

Decision:

That the Dedicated Schools Grant allocation and the methodology of its distribution be approved.

Reasons:

The Local Authority is obliged to account for and distribute funding received from the Government for the purposes of Education in accordance with the relevant legislative accounting procedure.

The Dedicated Schools Grant allocation for 2019/20 has been notified for the Local Authority as a total sum for 272,274,278 allocated in four blocks comprising the High Needs Block (£41,007,286), Early Years Block (£20,691,309), Schools' Block (£208,637,223), and the Central Schools Block (£1,938,460).

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Education, Children & Families Budget and Performance Monitoring Sub-Committee on 23rd January 2019 and the Committee supported the proposal.
