**CYCLE AND SCOOTER PARKING AT SCHOOLS**

**Reference Report:**

*Cycle and scooter parking at schools, 29/01/2020 Environment and Community Services Policy Development and Scrutiny Committee*

**Decision:**

That

1. The proposed cycle and scooter parking and installation in schools be approved.
2. Spending of £135k from the TfL Cycle Parking Implementation Fund allocated for this project be approved.

**Reasons:**

This proposal supports the children traveling actively, set out in Outcome 1 of Bromley's LIP3 which states that:

*"The types of intervention that should be identified in a School Travel Plan which the Council will consider funding need to contribute to increased active and public transport mode share, reduced car use, improved air quality and improved road safety in line with the Council's Zero KSI aspirations."*

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Environment and Community Services PDS Committee on 29 January 2020 and the Committee supported the proposal.
