The Portfolio Holder for Renewal, Recreation and Housing, Councillor Peter Morgan has made the following executive decision:

CONSIDERATION TO VARY CONTRACT FOR HYDROLOGICAL STUDY AND STRATEGY

Reference Report:

201207_Exemption to Vary by 90k_Gateway Member FINAL, 16/12/2020 Renewal, Recreation and Housing Policy Development and Scrutiny Committee

Decision:

An exemption is authorised to vary the contract value by £90,000.

Reasons:

Crystal Palace Park is shown within various designations and policies in the Local Plan and the London Plan. There is outline planning permission in place for the 2007 Masterplan, which established the planning principles of the Regeneration Plan.

The Regeneration Plan requires a separate planning consent which was submitted in January 2020 and is being determined. Once granted, a substantial research and repair project will be undertaken on the Crystal Palace dinosaurs. The hydrological study and strategy will inform this project.

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Renewal, Recreation and Housing PDS Committee on 16 December 2020 and the Committee supported the proposal.
