- 3) The Portfolio Holder granted authority to progress with 'Gully Charging' as one aspect of the project.

Reasons:

There is a need for a Council wide EV Charging Strategy to guide the installation of charging infrastructure in Bromley. This is to support LBB's organisational objectives and a borough wide transition to low or zero emissions vehicles before the 2030 ban on the sale of new petrol and diesel cars and vans.

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Environment and Community Services PDS Committee on 17th November 2021 and the Committee supported the proposal.
