BROMLEY YOUTH JUSTICE SERVICE UPDATE

Reference Report:

Bromley Youth Justice Service Update

Decision:

That the half-yearly update on the Bromley Youth Justice Service be endorsed.

Reasons:

The Bromley Youth Justice Service is a multi-disciplinary, multi-agency service with the statutory duty of supervising children and young people aged 10-18 years who are subject to Court orders to reduce first-time entrants to the Youth Justice System, prevent offending and reoffending, and reduce the use of custody for young people who are remanded or sentenced to custody. A wide range of interventions and specialist services have been put in place to support these three national outcome measures and the Bromley Youth Justice Service is a positive trajectory and performing well.

The proposed decision was scrutinised by the Children, Education and Families PDS Committee on 17 October 2022 and the Committee supported the proposal.
