3. COMMENTARY

General Purposes and Licensing Committee approved a Statement of Gambling policy for the period January 2010 to January 2013. The Council is the 'Licensing Authority' under the Act and must review and revise its policy as necessary but at least every three years. The next three year period commences on 7 January 2013 and runs until 6 January 2016.

This Policy sets out principals that the Council will apply when carrying out its functions under the Act.

The existing policy has not been altered in any substantial way from the current version but has been updated in respect of :-

- 1 Consultees
- 2 Maximum Stakes for Gaming Machines
- 3 Contact numbers

The draft policy was made available on the Councils Website between 13 August 2012 and 10 September 2012. Letters seeking comments on the proposed policy were sent to all licensed premises, Responsible Authorities, Residents Accusations and other pubic consultees as set out in the policy.

Four responses were received and these are included in appendix 1
