

3.1 This report provides an update of performance at the end of Quarter 3 in the delivery year 2013/2014.


Performance Indicator 3 Reduction in Levels of Recorded Anti-Social Behaviour





3.2 During the reporting period, the Borough has experienced a reduction of 263 (20%) incidents of ASB reported when compared with the same period last year.




3.3 As can be seen from the figure above, during the reporting period (October-December 2013), the Borough has experienced an increase of 34 (6%) incidents of Noise and Nuisance ASB reported when compared with the same period last year.




3.4 As can be seen from the figure above, during the reporting period, the Borough has experienced a reduction of 21(20%) incidents of Fly Tipping ASB reported when compared with the same period last year.

- 3.5 As can be seen from the figure above, during the reporting period, the Borough has experienced a reduction of 273 (51%) incidents of Graffiti ASB reported when compared with the same period last year.
- 3.6 Cray Valley West, Chelsfield & Pratts Bottom, Orpington and Farnorough & Crofton were the main hotspots wards for reporting graffiti incidents.



3.7 October to December 2013 the Borough has experienced an increase of 2 (2%) incidents of ASB reported when compared with the same period last year.
