



Footway Parking Permitted Partially On Footway

- A suitable footway width is retained to allow access
- Signs in place to allow exemption and to permit footway parking



Footway Parking Wholly On Footway

- Signs indicate that vehicles can park fully on the footway
- Footway width still allows pedestrians to gain access with some footway space retained



Footway Parking Not Permitted

- Vehicles parked on footway results in no space for pedestrians
- Footway parking would result in pedestrians walking along the road
