PHARMACEUTICAL NEEDS ASSESSMENT UPDATE

The formal consultation for the draft Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment commenced on 18th October 2017 and is due to run until midnight on 20th December 2017.

The Health and Wellbeing Board will have an opportunity to discuss the draft Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment at its meeting on 30th November 2017; these comments will be captured and fed into the formal consultation process.

Consultation feedback will be collated and presented to the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment Steering Group at its meeting on 8th January 2018. This will be discussed with a view to agreeing amendments to the draft Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment.

Webstar Lane will make the required amendments by 22nd January 2018 and the final Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment will be circulated to the Health and Wellbeing Board for approval at its meeting on 1st February 2018.

Webstar Lane will aim to ensure that the final Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment is ready for publication on 4th February 2018. This timescale assumes that there will be minor changes only following the meeting of the Health and Wellbeing Board on 1st February 2018.
