#### 1. Reason for report

1.1 Following pre-decision scrutiny at the Executive, Resources and Contracts PDS Committee on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021, the Executive considered the attached report on the Council Tax Support/Reduction Scheme 2022/23, including the results of public consultation, and recommended that Council approves the scheme. The 2022/23 scheme retains the calculation of entitlement for working age claimants on 75% of the household's Council Tax liability – thereby the maximum assistance provided to a claimant of working age is 75% of his/her Council Tax liability. The Scheme needs to be adopted by full Council before 31<sup>st</sup> January prior to the financial year that it relates to.

#### 2. RECOMMENDATION

The Council Tax Support/Reduction Scheme 2022/23 be approved, including the maintenance of the Discretionary Hardship Fund at £200k.
