1. Reason for report

1.1 At its meeting on 24th November 2021 the Executive considered the attached report setting out proposals for a housing and library improvement scheme in West Wickham town centre, and approved the proposals. The report had previously been scrutinised and supported by the Renewal, Recreation and Housing PDS Committee on 16th November 2021. The report summarises the RIBA Stages 0-3 work undertaken in relation to the site of the West Wickham Library and Station Road car park in West Wickham and sets out the options for the site, in order to seek a decision from elected members.
