

Oral Questions from Councillors

1) Question from Cllr Alisa Igoe

Is it correct that a request for pedestrian refuges to assist residents crossing Park Avenue (Plaistow Ward), a very wide straight road which suffers constantly from vehicles exceeding the speed limit, was refused and in particular, that the addition of a refuge opposite the exit from Parish CofE Primary School was refused?

Response to Question from Cllr Alisa Igoe:

**In response to an enquiry by Peter Morgan when he was one of the ward councillors it was estimated that the cost of providing a refuge would be £10,000 and would require the removal of a mature street tree. Requests for facilities such as refuges outside a school are made in a school's Travel Plan. Parish Primary School have made no such request, but should they add this as a request, then the Council will look at the necessity for such a refuge, its feasibility and the priority in respect of similar requests for funding.**
