Footprint started out in the film and TV industry making scenery for TV dramas such as Doc Martin & Spooks.


We now cover a wide range of industries including theatre, live events and retail

In 2012 we were honoured to work on the London 2012 opening ceremonies and produced over 1000 props for the Olympic and Paralympic opening ceremonies

We work globally having produced work for the Sochi Winter Games, the European Games in Baku and The Royal Opera House in Muscat among other notable projects.

Our most recent theatre work providing set and scenery include Jellyfish at the National Theatre, Macbeth and Twelfth Night at the Globe and Les Miserables and Phantom of the Opera for Cameron Macintosh.

Locally placed for our team, we have employed more local people since the move and the directors and existing team have an easier, quicker route to the workshop

We have started to employ an increasing number of local talent and are setting up education and training partnerships with local schools and colleges.
