1. Reason for report

1.1 The attached report from the Head of Food Safety, Occupational Safety and Licensing (<u>Appendix A</u>), was submitted for consideration by the General Purposes and Licensing Committee at its meeting held on 28 July 2010. Members fully supported the recommendations within the report and, in accordance with procedure, approval is now sought from Council to formally adopt the provisions.
